

Recreation Activities Report

May 19, 2020 – July 20, 2020

Scotts Flat Campground

Projects in Progress or Completed:

- Lower Division campgrounds and day-use areas opened July 3rd
- NID continues to work closely with the Nevada and Placer County Health Departments to make sure the most current State and County mandates and guidelines are being followed
- Scotts Flat office remains closed to the public; all business is being run through the Gatehouse.
- The POS (Point of Sales System) and laptops are in and will be installed after the summer season is over
- Operating on a reduced crew, currently have 30 temporary employees compared to the 60+ typically hired
- There are “COVID-19” signs posted throughout the campgrounds, even in the Upper Division campgrounds and dispersed camping areas
- The biggest challenge at the campgrounds is educating people on the difference between household members and immediate family
- Staff continues to educate campers and the public on the social distancing guidelines. Social distancing has proven to be quite a challenge, but the staff is doing their best to inform and educate
- Although this season is incredibly different than years past, the recreation staff both fulltime and temporary, are keeping a positive attitude and doing an excellent job

Future Projects:

- Painting the showers
- Replace the retaining wall between the marina store and the lake

Orchard Springs Campground

Projects in Progress or Completed:

- Included with Scotts Flat

Future Projects:

- Order picnic tables and umbrellas for the store picnic area
- Install a shade structure over the picnic and play area

Long Ravine Campground

Projects in Progress or Completed:

- Included with Scotts Flat

Future Projects:

- Work on the picnic area above the boat slip area

Peninsula Campground

Projects in Progress or Completed:

- Due to lack of staff, Peninsula will be closed for the camping season on July 24th. Peninsula will only be open for day use and boating

Future Projects:

- Creating a day-use/swim area

Upper Division, Jackson Meadows Campground

Projects in Progress or Completed:

- The dump station was repaired prior to opening after being vandalized the end of the 2019 camping season
- All tree work was completed before opening
- East Meadows, Pass Creek, and Woodcamp Campgrounds opened on July 3rd
- Fir Top is set to open on August 5th, and Findley will remain closed for the season
- All group campgrounds are closed for the season due to State and County guidelines
- Bowman Corridor is filled with campers everywhere, leaving trash and human waste behind. It has been left a mess for staff to clean up
- Faucherie Group Campground is closed; however, people are getting into the campground by cutting the gate chain or moving the barrier rocks

Future Projects:

- Replace gate and install steel fencing at Faucherie Group Campgrounds
- Tree work at Sawmill dispersed sites
- Replace all the campground barriers

Combie Reservoir

Projects in Progress or Completed:

- Dock owners have been billed their yearly dock fee; payments and Quagga forms are coming in
- Due to COVID-19, the yearly dock stickers will be mailed to dock owners

Future Projects:

- Work with NID's Encroachment Department to determine and start the clean-up process for all the non-authorized encroachments on Combie and other NID reservoirs

Greenhorn Campground

Projects in Progress or Completed:

- NID Recreation had repair work done to the sewer pumps and also fixed a broken sewer line
- Continue to inform the Liserra's on the most current State and County mandates and guidelines for camping, boating, and day-use, as it relates to COVID-19.

Future Projects:

- Continue to help the Liserra's when necessary and feasible. It's nice to work as a team
