RECOMMENDATION:

Award a construction contract to Hansen Bros. Enterprises for the Newtown Canal Grading Project in the amount of \$234,782, approve a budget transfer of \$46,782 from the Raw Water Replacement budget to the Extended CEQA budget and authorize the General Manager to execute the necessary documents.

BACKGROUND:

The intent of this work is to grade a portion of the abandoned Newtown canal for stormwater in the areas shown on the attached figure. The canal was abandoned when the canal was rerouted to the roadway in a pipeline as part of the Newtown Canal project. The regrading of the canal was a mitigation measure in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) document for this project. The District has received approval of the drainage plans by the property owners that this grading will be affecting. Due to budget constraints and design plans still in process the remaining portion of the canal will be regraded next year.

On June 13, 2018 a request for quotes was sent out to seven contractors for the Newtown Canal Grading Project. On July 16, 2018 Hansen Bros. Enterprises and T&S Construction submitted their quotes to the District in the amounts of \$234,782 and \$571,803, respectively.

Mitigation measures for the Newtown Canal will be followed per the adopted 2015 EIR document.

Staff recommends that the Board award the construction contract to Hansen Bros. Enterprises in the amount of \$234,782 in order to complete the grading for Lime, Berry, Vitavec and McLaughlin properties.

The CEQA Budget to be used for this project does not have sufficient funds to cover the entire contract amount. A budget transfer from the Raw Water Replacement Budget is recommended by staff to cover the project costs.

BUDGETARY IMPACT:


Funding for the project comes from the following two sources:

- \$188,000 of the project funding comes from the Extended CEQA program (10151-52913) leaving a balance of \$0 in this account.
- \$46,782 of the project funding comes from the Raw Water Replacement Budget (10151-52910) leaving a balance of \$239,271 in this account.
