- Fall/Winter water requests 9 denials due to inaccessible canals or previously scheduled outages
- End of irrigation season today and beginning of shutting down canals
- Treated water group produced 381.4-million gallons of water in September
- Thank you letter received from an Orr Creek Reservoir neighbor in appreciation of fire fuels clearing on District property
- Combie-Ophir Canal Bypass Project Update
- Lake Wildwood Backbone Extension Project update
- Hemphill Diversion Project update
- New insurance broker toured District facilities, including the Lake of the Pines and E. George Water Treatment Plants last week
- State Water Resources Control Board has accepted District Council's petition for reconsideration of fees for 2019 water rights
