

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-12 OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE NEVADA IRRIGATION DISTRICT

2023 Collection Agreement between NID and USFS

WHEREAS, On May 11, 2022, staff brought a discussion to the Board regarding not renewing the Special Use Permit with the USFS to operate and maintain USFS campgrounds and land within the Jackson Meadow Complex and Bowman Corridor. Instead, NID would enter into a collection agreement that would allow the District to pay the USFS to operate their campgrounds.

WHEREAS, The Board stated support for the proposed collection agreement and approved the 2022 Collection Agreement between the USFS and the District in the amount of \$348,870.

WHEREAS, The Recreation 2023 Operating Budget, budgeted \$383,757 in account 30250-52504 for the USFS 2023 Collection Agreement Financial Plan.

WHEREAS, NID staff has worked with the USFS on their 2023 Collection Agreement Financial Plan. The USFS 2023 Collection Agreement Financial Plan is requesting \$348,557, the funds would help operate and maintain their campgrounds and lands in the Jackson Meadows and Bowman Corridor areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Nevada Irrigation District to approve the following:

The General Manager is authorized to execute the 2023 Collection Agreement Financial Plan between Nevada Irrigation District and the United States Department of Agriculture, U.S. Forest Service, Tahoe National Forest.

- \$348,557 for the 2023 Collection Agreement.
- The balance of \$35,200 will remain in account 30250-52504 and will be used for a direct payment from NID to Sierra County for waste fees and for the USFS portion of water system operations.
