

Springtime Sprinkler Checklist

Controller

- Replace batteries if necessary
- Clean weather sensors
- Adjust irrigation schedule

Sprinkler Heads

- Adjust for adequate spray, coverage, and run-off
- Remove dirt and debris around heads
- Check for broken, cracked, or clogged heads

Valves

- Functioning properly
- Look for leaks

Wear and Tear

- Inspect and replace worn nozzles, valves and pipes
- Check water pressure for possible leaks



CONNECT

A leak as small as the tip of a pen can waste up to 6,300 gallon of water per month.



INSPECT

A broken sprinkler can waste up to 25,000 gallons of water in 6 months.



DIRECT

Be sure to spray on landscapes, not pavement
