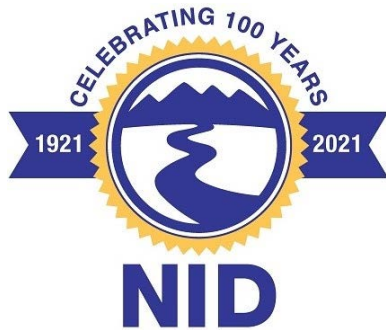

### **JOB OVERVIEW:**
