SUMMARY OF ITEMS ON THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS' AGENDAS

<u>CONSENT AGENDA</u>: The Consent Agenda consists of those items which are routine, and it is approved by one motion of the Board adopting the Consent Agenda and authorizing the appropriate actions.
