RECREATION

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt Resolution No. 2023-12 - Approving the 2023 Collection Agreement Financial Plan between Nevada Irrigation District (District) and the United States Department of Agriculture, U.S. Forest Service Tahoe National Forest (USFS) and authorize the General Manager to execute the appropriate documents.

BACKGROUND:

The recreational facilities listed below are part of the FERC Yuba-Bear Project #2266. Although the District is aware of no requirement of the Yuba-Bear FERC Project license or Federal Law or Regulation that would require the District to pay USFS to operate USFS Facilities, the District has indicated a willingness to support the operation of the facilities if a reasonable agreement could be reached.

- East Meadows Campground
- Pass Creek/Overflow Campgrounds
- Pass Creek and Woodcamp Boat Launches
- Aspen and Woodcamp Picnic Areas
- Jackson Point Campground
- Woodcamp Campground
- Fir Top Campground
- Findley Campground
- Jackson Creek and Canyon Creek Campgrounds
- Dispersed camping at Milton and Bowman Corridor

On May 11, 2022, staff brought a discussion to the Board regarding not renewing the Special Use Permit with the USFS to operate and maintain USFS campgrounds and land within the Jackson Meadow Complex and Bowman Corridor. Instead, NID would enter into a collection agreement that would allow the District to pay the USFS to operate and maintain their campgrounds. At that meeting, the Board stated support for the proposed collection agreement and approved the 2022 Collection Agreement between the USFS and the District in the amount of \$348,870.

Over the past several months, staff worked with the USFS on their 2023 Collection Agreement Financial Plan. The USFS 2023 Collection Agreement Financial Plan is requesting \$348,557, the funds would help the USFS operate and maintain their campgrounds and lands in the Jackson Meadows and Bowman Corridor areas. This Collection Agreement amount will be for 2023 only, all future agreements will be negotiated between NID and the USFS.

BUDGETARY IMPACT:

The 2023 Recreation Operating Budget includes \$383,757 in account 30250-52504 for the USFS 2023 Collection Agreement and contract service payments made by the District.

- \$348,557 for the USFS 2023 Collection Agreement Financial Plan.
- The balance of \$35,200 will remain in account 30250-52504 and will be used for a direct payment from NID to Sierra County for waste fees and for the USFS portion of water system operations.

WHEREAS, On May 11, 2022, staff brought a discussion to the Board regarding not renewing the Special Use Permit with the USFS to operate and maintain USFS campgrounds and land within the Jackson Meadow Complex and Bowman Corridor. WHEREAS, The Board stated support for the proposed collection agreement and approved the 2022 Collection Agreement between the USFS and the District in the amount of \$348,870.

WHEREAS, The Recreation 2023 Operating Budget, budgeted \$383,757 in account 30250-52504 for the USFS 2023 Collection Agreement Financial Plan.

WHEREAS, NID staff has worked with the USFS on their 2023 Collection Agreement Financial Plan. The USFS 2023 Collection Agreement Financial Plan is requesting \$348,557, the funds would help operate and maintain their campgrounds and lands in the Jackson Meadows and Bowman Corridor areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Nevada Irrigation District to approve the following:

The General Manager is authorized to execute the 2023 Collection Agreement Financial Plan between Nevada Irrigation District and the United States Department of Agriculture, U.S. Forest Service, Tahoe National Forest.

- \$348,557 for the 2023 Collection Agreement.
- The balance of \$35,200 will remain in account 30250-52504 and will be used for a direct payment from NID to Sierra County for waste fees and for the USFS portion of water system operations.
