- Maben Phase 3 Final connection remaining and asphalt piping

- Ironhorse and Armstrong Project District Financed Waterline Extension Project has begun construction
- Lake Wildwood to E. George design plans are being generated, and easements are being acquired for the project
- Hemphill meeting with Technical Advisory Committee is scheduled for October 8th
- The District will host ACWA Region 3 event on October 4th
- Seepage Workshop a for the October 15th Engineering Committee
